

ENPLANEMENT INFORMATION

Domestic

Continental provides service to 131 domestic destinations.¹ In 2007, the airline had another year of strong passenger growth with a 4% increase in enplanements over 2006 — the greatest increase of the major U.S. carriers.

Continental's hub cities are in critical regions in the South, Northeast, and Midwest. It is the largest carrier in each of its hubs.²

- In Houston, Continental has a 94% market share
- In the New York/Newark area, Continental dominates with a 83% market share
- Continental has an 80% share in the Cleveland market
